The team can be accessed through the Emergency Department at St. Mary's General Hospital and Cambridge Memorial Hospital. Confidential treatment options will be offered.  Can include medical care and treatment of injuries, pregnancy options, STI and drug screening, crisis support and safety planning, as well as evidence collection (survivors can talk about all or some of these topics).
