5 Indigenous Services Update Christina 5-10

Staffing Changes:

- Anastasia Alliance (Waterloo Coordinator) and Danielle (Director) are no longer with the college.
 - Anastasia resigned
 - Danielle's position was eliminated
 - * No current plans to rehire due to budget cuts.
- Operational Adjustments:
 - Christina and Jacob will alternate between Doon and Waterloo campuses to maintain coverage.
 - * Reduced presence at Reuter campus due to capacity issues.
- Concerns Raised:
 - Lack of communication from senior leadership regarding staffing changes.
 - Concerns about President Tibbits not attending the IEC meetings, especially when Director of Indigenous position was terminated.
 - Impact on Indigenous student support and trust in administration.
 - o Indigenous Student Success Strategy is complete but on hold until fall.
 - Conversation regarding the summary of the recommendations for the Indigenous Success Strategy that was emailed to the whole IEC on February 10th, 2025. At that time, the IEC was asked for their opinions, suggestions, and edits to the recommendations. There were no recommendations put forth. Confirmed in the meeting (members reviewing past emails) that the IEC did receive that email and that no edits were suggested.

- Proposal to reallocate unused RBC Co-op funding
 - \$40K-\$50K for building a Teaching Lodge (ceremonial space)
 - Remaining funds for student stipends (unpaid placements).





- Discussion Highlights:
 - o General support for the lodge and stipends.
 - o Concerns about RBC's corporate ethics (e.g., pipeline investments).
 - Emphasis on ensuring fair compensation for Indigenous knowledge carriers (e.g., Jordan White Eye).
 - Suggestions to expand student support beyond Co-op (e.g., residence support, awards, engagement-based stipends).
 - Consensus to move forward with the funding, with recommendations to diversify its use.
