Introduction

The Supply Chain Management Professional (SCMP) designation is Canada's principal and most sought-after professional designation for those entering the supply chain profession and advancing as leaders in supply chain,

Conestoga Is one of Ontario's fastest growing colleges and a leader in polytechnic education, Conestoga's career-focused education programs - from apprenticeships to diplomas, degrees to post-graduate certificates, continuing education and part-time studies - all reflect Ontario's changing Job market and will help students build the skills and knowledge that today's employers are seeking.

- Module 8: Supply Chain Management for Services, Capital Goods and Major Projects

- Interactive Workshop 1: Leadership and Professionalism
- Interactive Workshop 3: Communication and Relational Skills
- Interactive Workshop 5: Risk Management

To earn the SCMP designation, these candidates must meet the prescribed entry requirements and successfully complete the following academic program requirements:

- Module 1: Supply Chain Management
- Module 3: Logistics and Transportation
- Module 5: Knowledge Management
- Module 7: Supply Chain Management for the Public Sector
- Interactive Workshop 2: Negotiation Skills
- Interactive Workshop 4: Competitive Bidding, Contract Preparation and Contract Management
- Interactive Workshop 6: Ethical Behaviour and Social Responsibility

In addition to the academic requirements, candidates must also successfully complete SCMP Leadership Residency and the National Case-Study Examination. All SCMP candidates must also satisfy the three (3)-year work experience requirements (e.g. employment, internships and co-op placements).

Upon acceptance into the designation program, candidates can immediately begin using the post-nominal **SCMP (candidate)** to demonstrate their commitment to continuous professional development and the delivery of supply chain excellence.

Supply Chain Canada and Conestoga agree to work collaboratively in promotion and communication of this program and will release joint communications to target specific markets, all communications will be approved by both organizations,


- Encourage alumni and students to take advantage of the benefits of the "Academic Affiliate" and "Student" membership categories, which they can access through the Supply Chain Canada website.


